The farm primarily focuses on cultivating potatoes, small grains, and canola. It features 17 steel grain storage bins and a substantial 74,215 square feet of climate-controlled storage space spread across five large potato storage sheds. Additionally, the property boasts essential infrastructure, including a shop, an office with certified scales, and an equipment storage building. There are also two homes on-site, one for hired help and a comfortable main residence with corrals and sheds.

Water rights for the entire 1,910 acres are secured through Farmers Union. The farm's 12 center pivots, featuring brands like Reinke, Valley, and Lockwood, are in excellent condition. As of 2023, the property is under lease, and lease details are available.
